Annotation

The subject of study of the course "Software in BU" is the theory and practice of using computer programs for successful accounting.

The purpose of teaching this discipline is to form students' knowledge in the field of using computer programs in accounting. The objective of the course is to form students' complex of theoretical and practical knowledge in the use of these programs. As part of the course, students will be introduced to the software that registers various accounting transactions and acts as a systematizer of accounting information.

A prerequisite for consolidating and deepening knowledge is the participation of students in seminars, as well as the implementation in practice of various economic and accounting operations using software.

The program of the course "Software in BU" contains a practical and theoretical analysis of the implementation of accounting using software based on the current accounting standards and the taxation system, provided for study by students of the III and IV courses of the Faculty of Economics, majoring in "Economics" (bachelor's degree). The discipline is designed for 72 academic hours, of which 36 are classroom hours (18 hours of lectures and 18 hours of seminars).

The lectures are supposed to outline the basics of using software and accounting standards. Seminars include working out the issues discussed in the lectures in the software, students independently carry out operations in the program, the seminar provides additional explanation of the most difficult issues in a general and individual manner. The independent work of students includes post-seminar study of assignments, practical cases and tasks, familiarization with legislative acts in the field of accounting and tax accounting.

According to the curriculum for the specialty "Economics", this discipline involves 2 credits, 1 final module.

The grade obtained for the final module is taken as the grade of the exam.
