Annotation.

The course is a systematic presentation of the scientific foundations of project management as a type of management activity. It reveals the content of the main categories of project management, outlines the evolution of its approaches, presents the essence and content of the main processes, tools and functional areas of project management. The content of the course is based on the need for students to master the theoretical and practical foundations of preparation and management decision-making in the field of project management.

Relationship with other disciplines of the specialty: the course "Project Management" is closely interconnected with such disciplines of the specialty "Management" as "Theory of Management", "Theory of Organization", "Quality Management", "Risk Management", "Human Resources", "Financial Management", "Logistics", "Marketing" and others.

Requirements for the initial levels of knowledge and skills of students: basic knowledge of the basics of theory and practice of management, skills in system analysis of phenomena and processes in an organization.

The purpose and objectives of the discipline.
