Abstract: This course examines the problems of economic regulation, such as: price (tariff) and non-price regulation of natural monopolies, antitrust and competition policy in infrastructure industries (electricity, railway transport, gas industry, telecommunications), the use of new tools to stimulate regulation, formation of independent regulatory bodies, etc., problems of combating monopolization of various clusters and business segments associated with costs of the transition period. The institutional foundations of the state policy on antitrust regulation of the economy in developed and transitional countries.

Both scientific-theoretical and practical aspects of implementation are studied. state antimonopoly policy.
