4 ECTS, 144 academic hours.

Control form: exam.

Summary. The course material examines the essence of accounting and analysis of economic activities, the purpose and role of accounting and analysis of economic activity when making management decisions at the micro level.

Students will learn how to apply accounting information to analyze business activities, drawing up plans and budgets, determining the break-even point, pricing, etc.

This course is designed to prepare bachelors in RAU on specialization "economy". Within the framework of this discipline, the basic principles of accounting accounting and the basis for the analysis of economic activity. To this end, within the framework of this course the basics of accounting are studied. Basic methods of analysis are also studied economic activity.

The aim of this course is:

• Familiarization and acquisition of knowledge and understanding of students about accounting and analysis of economic activity.

Relationship with other disciplines of the specialty: course "Accounting and Analysis" is interconnected with such disciplines of the specialty "Economics" as "Microeconomics" and "Financial Accounting".
