## Annotation.

The course "Political Economics" is devoted to the study of basic theoretical and practical issues related to the transition of the countries of the post-Soviet space, as well as the countries of the former socialist camp from the system of the administrative-command economy to the market one.

Special attention will be paid to the transitional processes in the Republic of Armenia, as in the field of economics and in the field of politics. Within the framework of this discipline, students will study practical issues related to the specifics of transition processes in each individual country, models of the transition from a planned economy to a market economy will be considered. The problems of monetary, fiscal, foreign economic, antimonopoly and social policies of the state in the process of transition will be studied, the positive and negative consequences of the reforms will be assessed. The issues of the state policy of the transition period in the Republic of Armenia will be considered in detail.

The course "Political Economics" is aimed at the development of practical and analytical thinking of students, undergraduates and graduate students in various specialties. This course helps to take political factors into account when analyzing complex economic processes. On the other hand, discussions and discussions on topical issues of politics and economics help prepare students for practical activities, help to navigate in two and multilateral economic relations, take into account the factor of the political environment and foreign policy characteristics of states and various market participants when developing business and economic strategies.
