**B1.B11 World economy and international economic relations**

***Annotation***

Labor intensity: 4 ECTS, 144 academic hours.

Control form: exam.

Abstract: The subject studies the patterns of development of the world economy and gives an idea of the main forms and directions of international economic relations. In this discipline, students get an idea of the patterns of development of international trade, the factors influencing international trade and the forms of its organization and regulation.

The course also includes the main forms of international trade in goods and services, as well as the spheres and forms of ensuring the functioning of foreign trade, which constitute the UMKD.

The main goal of the course is to familiarize students with the basic theoretical and practical issues arising in the field of international economic relations and international trade, international finance and international financial relations.

Relationship with other disciplines of the specialty: the course "World Economy and International Economic Relations" is interconnected with such disciplines of the specialty "Economics" as "Microeconomics", "Macroeconomics", "International Monetary Relations", etc.
