Summary: The course covers the main sections of a typical training course "Finance". The material gives a comprehensive understanding of the country's financial system and its basic elements. The logic of the functioning of public finances is considered, finance of enterprises and households; and international finance.

As a result of studying the basic part of the cycle, the student should know the patterns functioning of modern finance, money circulation and credit (for macro- and micro level); the main results of the latest research in the field of financial, monetary theory, software, features of the functioning of monetary credit and financial institutions, their areas of activity, modern products and services of these economic agents; modern methods of analysis of financial markets, financial and credit institutions, strategies and models of their management.

Relationship with other disciplines of the specialty: the course "Finance" is interconnected with such disciplines of the specialty "Economics" as "Microeconomics", "Macroeconomics". Requirements for the initial levels of knowledge and skills of students: The student must have basic knowledge of statistics, mathematical analysis, game theory,
