*Summary*

This course is devoted to the study of the specifics of the exports and imports policy of the Republic of Armenia. Considering that the economy of Armenia can be characterized as import-dependent, and the export of goods and services of the country has a low degree of diversification, a competent exports and imports policy has a key role in reducing the above dependence, as well as expanding the sales markets for the products of export-oriented sectors of the RA economy. Special attention will be paid to the specifics of the exports and imports policy of the Republic of Armenia in the context of its membership in the EAEU, as well as its involvement in the GSP + regime.

The course will also study the priority directions of export development in the RA and the impact of the exports and imports policy pursued by the state on economic growth.

The discipline closely correlates with such specialty disciplines as: «Macroeconomics. Advanced Course», «Mega-economics», «Modern Economic Policy of the Republic of Armenia», «Customs Policy».
